Overview

Students will explore the pitfalls and challenges of putting together and managing large sets of data.

Lesson Summary

- One of the main aspects of the lesson is to assist students in selecting a possible research topic for the final Unit project.
- First Activity: Review videos provided in CS content as possible sparks to ignite student's interest in a given topic.
- Second Activity: Student will complete a journal prompt.
- Third Activity: Assign data collection for homework
- Fourth Activity: Students will work in groups to merge and narrow down their data so at the conclusion of class the group should have a well-formatted file for data collecting
