

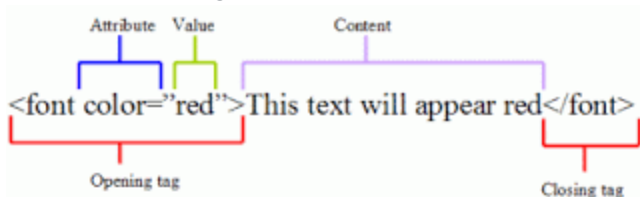
Lesson #14: Hyperlinks

Overview

This lesson explores the use of links to other websites.

Lesson Summary

- Introduce a tag
- Explain html rules (see pic below)
 - tags are enclosed in angle brackets
 - tags usually come in pairs - opening tag and closing tag.
 - the text to be modified goes between the opening and closing tag.
 - Most opening tags require the use of attributes and values. The attribute for creating a link is href which stands for "hypertext reference". The value for creating a link will be the url you want to link to.
 - Values always are enclosed in quotation marks.
 - Attributes are always separated from values by an equal sign.
